Gone to the Dogs: A Canine Carnival

Visitor Guidelines

The Mabee-Gerrer Museum of Art is pleased to host a gallery tour and canine carnival that “Speaks” to all members of the family—including the dog! In celebration of this special exhibit the museum invites your artfully adorned dog or creative canine to participate in a variety of artistic endeavors at *Gone to the Dogs: A Canine Carnival*.

The MGMTMoA promotes and encourages responsible dog ownership. You and your dog’s comfort and safety is important to us. We ask that all guardians with canine companions adhere to the following guidelines during your visit:

- Dogs will only be permitted in designated areas and must be kept on leash. Leashes should be no longer than 6 feet and should be kept in the hands of an adult. Please do not use retractable leashes.
- All dogs should be current on vaccinations. A combination DHLPP and Rabies vaccination are required. Puppies that are under 5 months and not fully vaccinated may participate at their own risk. Name tags, current license and rabies tags must be visible on your dog’s collar. Dogs should be free of parasites which include fleas, ticks, and worms.
- Dogs should be well socialized and should be able to behave around other dogs and people. Dogs that are stressed by crowds and or display aggressive tendencies should not participate. **You are responsible for the actions of your dog.** Any dog that shows signs of stress or aggression will be asked to leave.
- Dogs should be encouraged to relieve themselves in designated areas only. Be prepared to pick up! Poop bags and waste canisters will be available on site.
- You are ultimately responsible for the comfort and safety of your dog. Please use caution during hot and humid conditions. Cooling stations are available throughout the MGMTMoA *Gone to the Dogs* site to help your dog stay cool and well hydrated.
- All city, county, and state rules and guidelines apply.
