Conditions:

1. The Borrower agrees to abide by the guidelines for loans as set out below. These conditions may be modified only in writing and with the approval of the Curator of Education.
2. Objects borrowed from the MGMTMoA shall be given special care at all times to guard against loss, damage, and deterioration.
3. On return the loan must be packed in the same manner as received and with the same cases, pads, and packing materials. In cases of damage to packing materials, the Borrower must contact the MGMTMoA Curator of Education (listed above).
4. Any changes in the condition of the loan objects (variation from the stated guidelines in this agreement, loss, thefts, or damage to the loan) in transit, during storage or in the process of being used must be reported immediately to the MGMTMoA Curator of Education.
5. **The Borrower is responsible for incoming and outgoing reports. The Borrower is responsible for sending both reports directly to the MGMTMoA.**
6. If the Borrower is shipping the Trove to the Museum or a MGMTMoA-approved location, he/she must directly contact the MGMTMoA with a tracking number and date of shipping.
7. In the event of damage to the loaned objects while in the custody of the Borrower, the Borrower will be responsible for the cost of all repairs and replacements necessary to return the loan objects to the previous condition. No alteration, restoration or repair shall be undertaken by the Borrower without the prior written consent of the MGMTMoA.
8. The loaned objects must not be individually photographed, filmed, televised, or reproduced without the express, written prior consent of the MGMTMoA.
9. The MGMTMoA reserves the right to recall the loan at any time if these conditions are not met and disclaims any liability resulting from such action.

The Borrower acknowledges that he/she has full power to execute the agreement that he/she has read and understands the conditions of the loan as outlined on the front and back of this form and attached documents.
